 - If yes, what made you chose this particular brand over others?
 - 9.2. What water filtration system brands do you currently trust in the market?
 - 9.3. Why do you trust them? What makes them trustworthy in your opinion?
 - 9.4. What would be your red flag to trust a water filtration brand?
- 10. [Decision factors] Why did you decide on this water filtration system in the end?
 - 10.1. What made you go for that system?

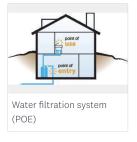
